

Florida Medical Marijuana Patient ID Card Process

Start here:

Visit a Recommending Physician

Visit www.KnowtheFactsMMJ.com to find a physician near you allowed to recommend medical marijuana in the state of Florida.

Make an appointment to see this provider and bring proof of your qualifying condition.

Every 35 Days

Your "Smokeable Marijuana" recommendation will renew for up to 2.5 ounces.

The products that qualify under this category are whole flower, pre-rolls, ground flower or shake.

Don't Leave Home Without It

Patients are always required to have their medical marijuana card or acceptance email on them while in possession of product.

Product must always be labeled with exit labels properly stating the patient's name, their physician, the product purchased and other critical details.

Caregiver 101

Florida allows someone close to a patient to become their caregiver and purchase medical cannabis on their behalf.

A caregiver is required to register with the state, take a short intro class and keep their caregiver's ID card on them at all times while transporting product.

45 Days Before Expiration

45 days before your medical card expires you will receive a reminder that it's time to renew.

All information needs to be up to date on your MMUR card so now is a great time to update your address, name, etc.

After processing your renewal fee, you'll receive an emailed receipt. When your renewal is accepted, you'll receive an email indicating your acceptance.

Receive your Patient ID #

10-14 business days after submitting your application and \$75 payment to the state you will receive an email indicating whether your application has been approved.

It may take several weeks for your physical card to arrive in the mail.

Don't worry though - once approved you can begin shopping right away using the acceptance email and your driver's license.

Every 70 Days

Your "Medical Marijuana" and "Low-THC Cannabis" recommendations will renew with fresh allowances.

The limit of your allowance is determined by your doctor during your initial visit. Products that qualify under these categories are vape pens, gel capsules, tinctures and topicals.

7 Months After Being Approved

After three 70-day supplies, or 7 months, have passed it's time to head back to your physician for your follow-up visit.

Use this visit to communicate any changes in your medical marijuana needs to your doctor.

Renewal 101

Patient and caregivers are required to renew their cards with the state of Florida once a year.

Renewal is usually as simple as paying an additional \$75 to the state through the online MMUR portal.

1 Year After Being Approved

The expiration date listed on your medical marijuana card is one year from the date of acceptance.

The card expires at the start of the date indicated, so unfortunately you will not be able to shop on the expiration date.
